Academic English Expectations

Final grade of **B, B+, A or A+**

- English Condition satisfied. Eligible for full-time studies.

Final grade of **B-** (working hard)

- Fall/Winter part-time Academic English (4hrs/week) + reduced course load.

Final grade of **C+ C, C-, or D** (working hard)

- Fall full-time Academic English (September to December).

Failing grade or not working hard or bad behaviour

- Offer of Admission withdrawn.

Passport



Temporary Resident Visa (TRV)



- Your valid passport and ETA or TRV (valid temporary resident visa)
- The letter of introduction from the visa office that you received when your study permit was approved (for international students)
- Your offer of admission letter and a copy of the 2024 Academic Program fee receipt
- Proof of enough funds
- If applicable, your pre-paid first-year tuition fee

Health and Wellness: Your Health Insurance Plan

University Health Insurance Plan (UHIP) UHIP is a mandatory medical insurance plan for all international students

- Health care coverage parallel to Canadian residents
- Automatic enrollment for 12 months (September 1, 2024 - August 31, 2025)
- When in Toronto, print your UHIP card via your online account
- Show your UHIP card to access these services

SCSU Extended Health & Dental Insurance Coverage

- From the time you arrive in Toronto until August 31, all students will be covered with University Health Insurance and Supplementary Insurance (Prescription)
- Medical insurance for undergraduate students (September 1 - August 31 of the following year) All students are covered by university health insurance and additional insurance (prescription, dental, eyes, etc.)

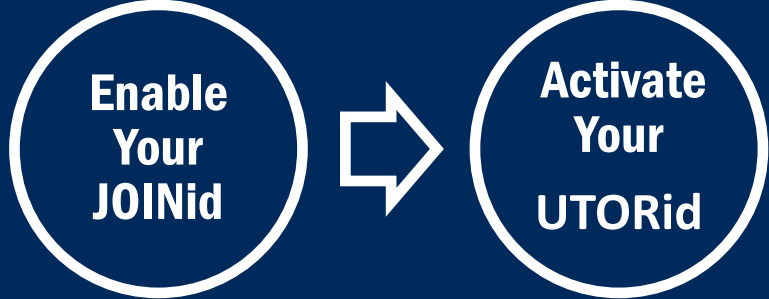

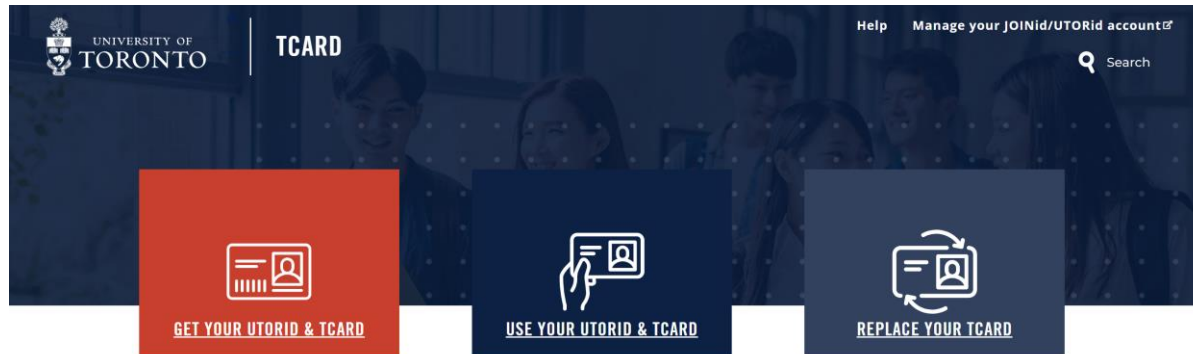

3. SUBMIT PHOTO + DOCUMENTATION ONLINE.
4. CHECK YOUR EMAIL FOR APPROVAL OF YOUR SUBMISSION.
5. CONVERT YOUR JOINID TO A UTORID. ACTIVATE YOUR UTORID.
6. WHEN YOU'RE ON CAMPUS, PICK UP YOUR TCARD.

- **All students must still activate their UTORid**
- **TCards are not required if you are studying remotely.**

What's the difference between my TCard and UTORid?

TCard:

- Your physical identification for U of T on-campus services
- Provides access to on-campus facilities: Library, Pan Am, Building/Lab access, Food services, Printing services, etc.

UTORid:

- Your login to U of T online services
- Provides access to your UTmail+, ACORN, Quercus, etc.

How to activate your UTORid - Summary

Step 1: Find your legal status in [ACORN](#). Then, use the [Documents Tool](#) to determine which documents, you must submit to verify your identity and legal status.

Step 2: Submit your photo for the TCard and your identity & legal status documentation via [CloudCard](#).

Step 3: Once your submission has been approved, you will receive your Secret Activation Key (SAK) AND instructions on how to [activate your UTORid](#) via email. Follow the steps to convert your JOINid to your UTORid and set up your U of T email.

What is JOINid / UTORid?

- ➔ JOINid and UTORid is the same ID:
 - ➔ Applicants use JOINid
 - ➔ Registered students: JOINid changed to UTORid
- ➔ **All students will receive this JOINid via email.**
- ➔ **Enable JOINid first, then activate your UTORid**
- ➔ UTORid is the one single ID you will use across your entire studies at U of T
- ➔ U of T Student Card (TCard): provide photo, and verify your ID, you can pick up your TCard once you arrive on campus

First step: enable JOINid

For Academic English students, your JOINid is enabled when you apply from OUAC. If anyone does not enable the JOINid, you need to enable your JOINid before you can access any U of T resources. <https://tcard.utoronto.ca/get-your-utorid-tcard>

DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENTS

Use the documentation tool to determine the identity and legal status documentation you'll need to get your UTORid and TCard; the documentation required will depend on who you are, and whether this is your first UTORid and TCard.

Your documentation must be unexpired and original (digital or photocopies are not acceptable).

The name displayed on your identity/legal status documentation must exactly match the official name in the University's record systems (e.g. [ACORN](#), [IRIS](#)).

You may want to check your name/legal status in ACORN or Accurus before having your UTORid set up and appointment.

If it's not accurate, or you need to change the first or last name listed in the University's system (ACORN/IRIS), contact your [REGISTRATION](#) or business office before completing the UTORid & TCard process.

WHY WE VERIFY YOUR IDENTITY AND LEGAL STATUS

To obtain a UTORid & TCard, your identity must be verified so:

- support safety, security and identity management at the University
- ensure your access to our official systems is accurate

To begin studies at the University of Toronto, your [legal status](#) (e.g., Canadian, permanent resident, international) must be verified to:

- meet the reporting requirements of the University of Colleges and Institutes and Immigration Canada
- ensure you're paying the correct tuition fees

Next Step: Submit your TCard Photo

Photo & Documentation Requirements:

- Photos and documents files must be in **JPEG, PNG** or **GIF**.
- Portrait photos includes shoulders and space above the head, with face looking at the camera. It's OK to smile!
- Portraits must be in colour and not include other objects (hats, sunglasses, etc.) or other people.
- No facial enhancements or changes to facial structure, and no pictures of pictures.
- Portrait photo must match the photo in your identity/legal status documentation.
- Identity/legal status documentation must be in colour and unexpired.

5. CONVERT YOUR JOINID TO A UTORID. ACTIVATE YOUR UTORID.

Soon after receiving your photo approval email, you will receive an email with instructions on how to activate your UTORid, using your **Secret Activation Key (SAK)**:

- Newly admitted students receive their SAK via email after their photo & documentation has been approved.
- The SAK email will be sent to the email address listed in [ACORN\(opens in a new tab\)](#), unless you provided an alternate email during the submission process.
- The email will come from a U of T email address: infosec@utoronto.ca. The subject line will be “**Activate Your U of T UTORid**”.
- If your JOINid has stopped working AND you haven't received your SAK email, check your junk and spam folder.
- The email contains a SAK and a link to activate your UTORid.

New students

You will require a Secret Activation Key (SAK) in order to activate your UTORid. This SAK would have been sent to you by email[†] during your identity verification appointment with a TCard staff member, or it was provided to you by your registrar or another authorized U of T staff member. Visit card.utoronto.ca to learn more about what a UTORid is and how to get one + your SAK.

- Enter your JOINid + Secret Activation Key below, to activate your UTORid and UTmail+
- **Important:** Once you create your UTmail+ account, it will **replace** the current email address you have in the U of T record system, and all new **university communications will automatically be sent to your new U of T email address.**

- *Your email address will be in the form of **firstname.lastname@mail.utoronto.ca** unless that name is already in use – then there will be a suffix applied, or you may select your own variation.*
- **Log in to your account at mail.utoronto.ca using your UTORid and password.**

- E-mail, calendar and Teams
- 1TB of storage in your OneDrive
- **FREE** Microsoft Office Suite (O365) for your desktop and tablet for the duration of your academic enrolment
