- The Health & Wellness Centre, located in the Student Centre (SL-270), is a student service that provides health care and counselling services, and promotes wellness on campus. We have doctors, nurses, counsellors and student volunteers who support University of Toronto Scarborough students in maintaining their overall health and wellbeing.
- Before coming to UTSC, we strongly encourage you to review your immunization with your family doctor, using the charts below, to ensure your health is protected while you pursue your studies.
- You are also welcome to book an appointment with us to receive any outstanding vaccinations. To book an appointment, please call or drop-in with your valid T-Card and health card.

Vaccine	Ontario Schedule Recommendations
Measles, Mumps, Rubella (also known as MMR)	2 doses as a child OR 2 doses 28 days apart as an adult
Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (also known as Tdap)	3 doses before age 18, and a booster every 10 years
Varicella	2 doses as a child OR 2 doses as a young adult if not immune
Meningococcal Conjugate ACYW-135	1 dose in Grade 7
Hepatitis B	2 doses in Grade 7
Human Papillomavirus (Gardasil®9)	2 doses in Grade 7
Polio	Immunized as an infant
<i>Haemophilus influenzae</i> type b	Immunized as an infant
Meningococcal Conjugate C	Immunized as an infant
Pneumococcal	Immunized as an infant
Influenza	Every year in the fall

Please note that some of these vaccines are publicly funded and others may have a cost associated, which may be covered through your SCSU Health & Dental Plan as of September.

Vaccine	Additional Vaccine Recommendations by the Health & Wellness Centre for Post-Secondary Students
COVID 19 For more information, see here	2 doses + a booster of any Health Canada-approved vaccine OR 3 doses + a booster of any other vaccine are recommended <small>*COVID vaccines are a requirement for students living in residence</small>
Human Papillomavirus (Gardasil® 9)	3 doses for those over 15 years of age who did not previously receive it
Meningococcal Conjugate ACYW-125	At 12 to 24 years of age

Vaccine	Additional Vaccine Recommendations for Post-Secondary Students
Meningococcal sero B	2 doses one month apart
Hepatitis A	2 doses 6-36 months apart
