We are aware that there is graffiti at various locations on campus. Campus Safety and Toronto Police Service are investigating, and staff are in the process of cleaning up the graffiti. We understand that these acts of vandalism may be concerning for members in our community. We are monitoring closely and are not aware of any safety concerns at this time.
