Use of Generative AI in the Course

Please confirm with your instructor whether a technology tool such as ChatGPT is permitted to use on an assignment. Faculty at the University are aware of this technology, and encourage discussion of the limitations and potential of these tools.

The Issue

Be aware that the University expects students to complete their own work and generate ideas independently.

If your instructor prohibits the use of generative AI for assignments, then using it is considered an academic offence.

Also, be advised that generative AI sometimes generates erroneous information that can be easily spotted by your instructors.

Generate Study Guides

Use generative AI tools to prepare study plans to help manage your time efficiently, including:

- Generate practice test questions
- Explain course concepts
- Translate lecture notes

Preview Courses

Summarize Your Notes

After each lecture or reading, you can use generative AI to summarize **YOUR** notes to make more concise tip sheets and summary slides.
